Would you like to be able to identify more of our local wildlife? This **FREE** event will help you to identify a variety of wildlife that can be seen on a stroll around the north of Peterhead, Aberdeenshire. Starting at the River Ugie estuary, it will be led by Glenn Roberts of the North East Scotland Biological Records Centre (NESBReC) with some walking along uneven terrain required. Learn how to record the different species that you see and how to submit those records to NESBReC for inclusion in a local wildlife database.
